STANDARD SPECIAL CONDITIONS FOR SEX OFFENDERS

1. Totally abstain from the consumption of any alcoholic beverage.
2. Be placed in the Intensive Supervision Unit for a period of one (1) year from the date of judgment and report each week or as directed by the Community Supervision Officer.
3. Attend, pay for, actively participate in, and successfully complete a sex offender treatment program approved by the Community Supervision and Corrections Department. Submit to and pay for any psychological testing at the direction of the treatment provider or the Community Supervision Officer.
4. Do not reside in the same residence with minor(s) including the defendant's children without permission of the court.
5. Pay a \$5.00 per month Sexual Assault Program Fund fee beginning the month following entry of this order.
6. Do not initiate or maintain any contact with any minor under the age of seventeen (17) except as allowed by the Community Supervision and Corrections Department through an approved chaperone program. Follow all rules and regulations of said chaperone program(s).
7. Comply with all sex offender registration requirements as set forth in Chapter 62 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.
8. Do not be employed where you may have direct contact with minor children without prior written permission from the Community Supervision Officer.
9. Submit to and pay for a polygraph examination as directed by the Community Supervision Officer and/or the Court.
10. Abide by any curfew imposed by the Community Supervision Officer.
11. Do not visit places where minors normally congregate (schools, playgrounds, parks, fast food places that cater to children, toy stores, toy departments of other stores, etc.).
12. Submit to DNA testing at the direction of the Community Supervision Officer and pay the provider the cost of the testing.

13. Reimburse the appropriate law enforcement agency for cost incurred for community notification through local newspapers.
14. Do not go in, on, or within 1,000 feet of a premises where children commonly gather, including a school, daycare facility, playground, public or private youth center, public swimming pool, or video arcade facility.
15. Do not frequent or patronize any place or patronize any place where pornographic materials are sold, rented, leased, displayed, or viewed. Do not own, rent, lease, display, possess, or view any kind of pornographic material. Do not enter any sexually oriented establishment.
16. Do not engage in communication or interaction, through the use of any computer, with any child under the age of seventeen (17).
17. Do not possess, acquire, obtain, retain, or review journalistic video, photographic, electronic, compact disk, computer generated or computer originated material, or material generated by an individual or material that is sent or received by electronic mail that is sexually oriented and/or portrays nudity of a child or an adult.
18. Submit to computer and Internet monitoring at your expense as directed by your Community Supervision Officer. Follow all Community Supervision and Corrections Department rules and regulations relating to computer and Internet usage.
19. Permit the supervision officer into his/her residence, and allow a reasonable review of any video, audio, photographic, computer-related material, or printed media in the home.
20. Submit to the Abel screen assessment, at your own expense, at the direction of the probation officer and/or psychologist.
21. Pay the cost of counseling and/or medical expenses required for the victim as determined by the Bowie County Community Supervision and Corrections Department for a period of up to one (1) year.

NOTE- Exact wording on individual judgments may vary. Standard conditions are periodically revised, and so older judgments may differ. Probationers transferred in from
